







Il était une fois un minibus appelé Tin Trong. Chaque jour, Tin Trong parcourait un très long chemin.

Il rentra très tard se garer sur sa place de parking.




Il se mit à tousser. *Kof! Kof! Kof!* Il était tellement malade qu'il décida de ne pas rouler le lendemain.

Il savait exactement ce qu'il devait faire pour se rétablir. Il devait subir une révision complète, puis se reposer.


Cric! Cric! Tap! Tap! Bang! Bang!



Cric! Cric! Tap! Tap! Bang! Bang!


Aaah, Tin Trong se sentait mieux!

Il se sentait même beaucoup mieux!




Tin Trong demanda une dernière petite faveur : une bonne douche!
