A chaque Pongal, c'est la fête des moissons, elle était autorisée à faire un kolam toute seule.




Susheela adorait faire des kolams!

... sur les trains et sur les façades des grands immeubles...




... même sur des cerfs-volants qui se lançaient dans le ciel.

... et en quelques minutes, un gigantesque kolam, magnifique et coloré se trouvait dans le ciel, et tout le monde pouvait le voir dans la ville!






Cette nuit-là, Susheela se tenait sur sa terrasse et leva les yeux au ciel.
