


Yapo adore jouer avec son ballon de football ! Il essaie souvent des feintes de dribble avec son papa.Une roulette, un passement de jambe et même...


... une bicyclette !



Yapo était très heureux que son équipe ait gagné 3 à 2. Mais il était un peu déçu de n'avoir marqué aucun but.




« Félicitations pour le retourement de situation ! » s'enthousmait l'entraîneur Tazi.
