





« Mais comment pouvons-nous les ouvrir ? » demandèrent les autres.





Les singes se moquaient des tortues maladroites.




Les tortues essayèrent de mordre dans le fruit. Mais elles n'y arrivaient pas !

Bouh !




Les tortues essayèrent de les ouvrir avec leurs pieds malhabiles.

Bouh !




Elles essayèrent de casser les fruits avec leur tête.

Elles essayèrent de faire tremper le fruit pour le ramollir ... mais les pommes ont dansé sur l'eau de l'étang.


Bouh ! Bouh ! Bouh !
