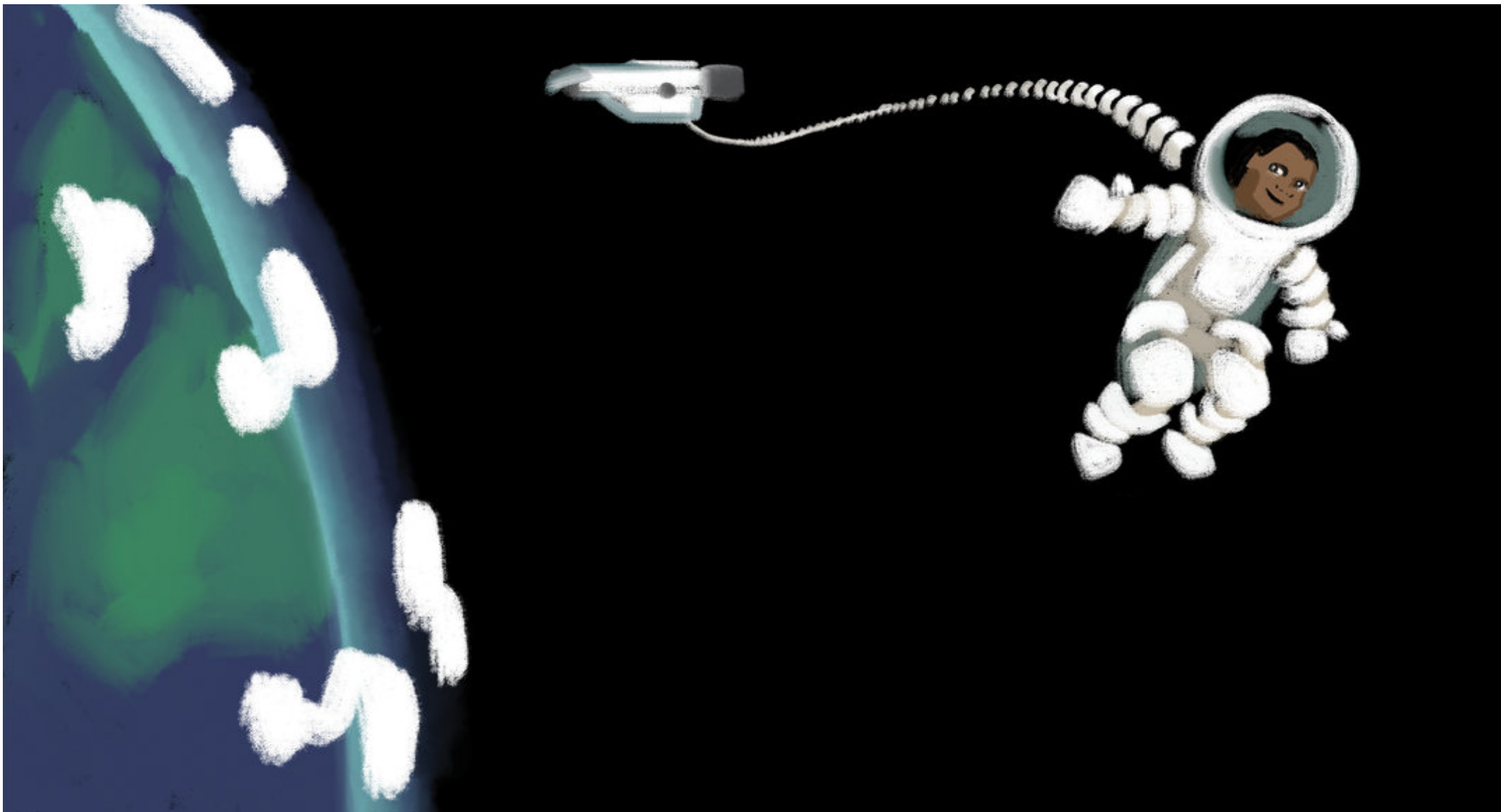
Tig possède un globe terrestre.

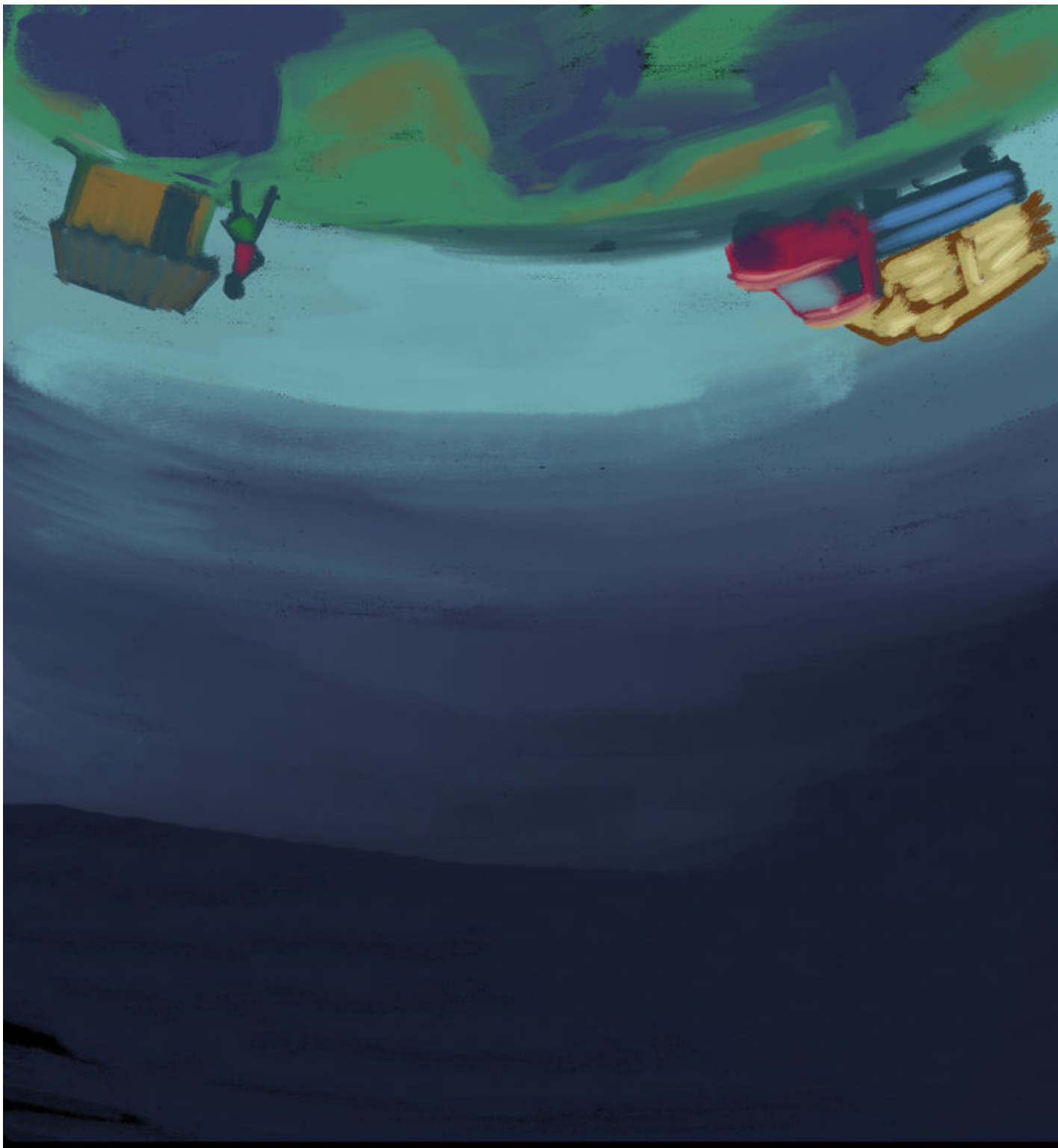
— Parce que la gravité attire tout le monde vers le centre de la Terre.

Les gens de l'autre côté de la Terre pensent qu'ils sont dans le bons sens...

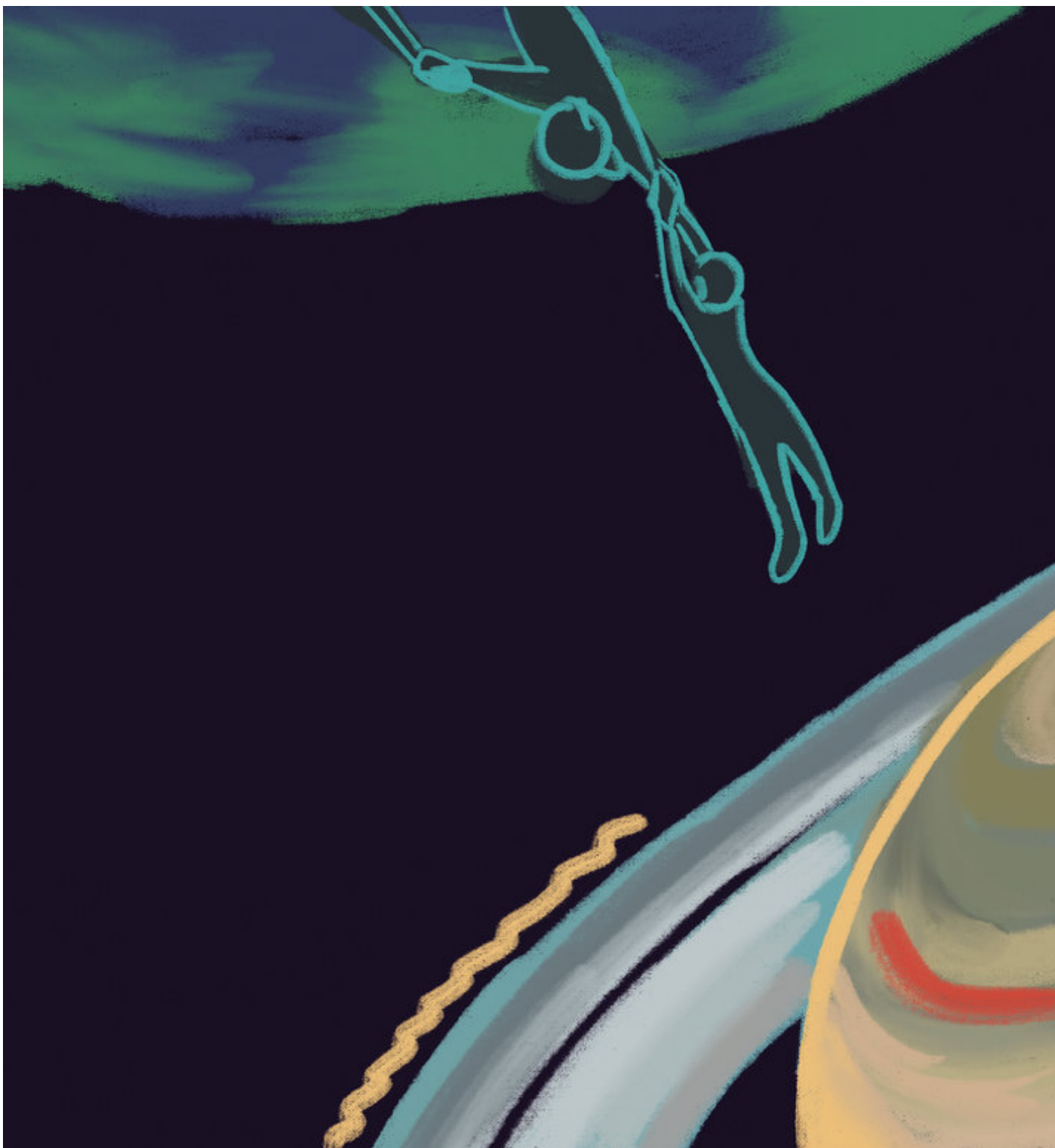


...et que c'est nous qui sommes à l'envers. Incroyable, non ?

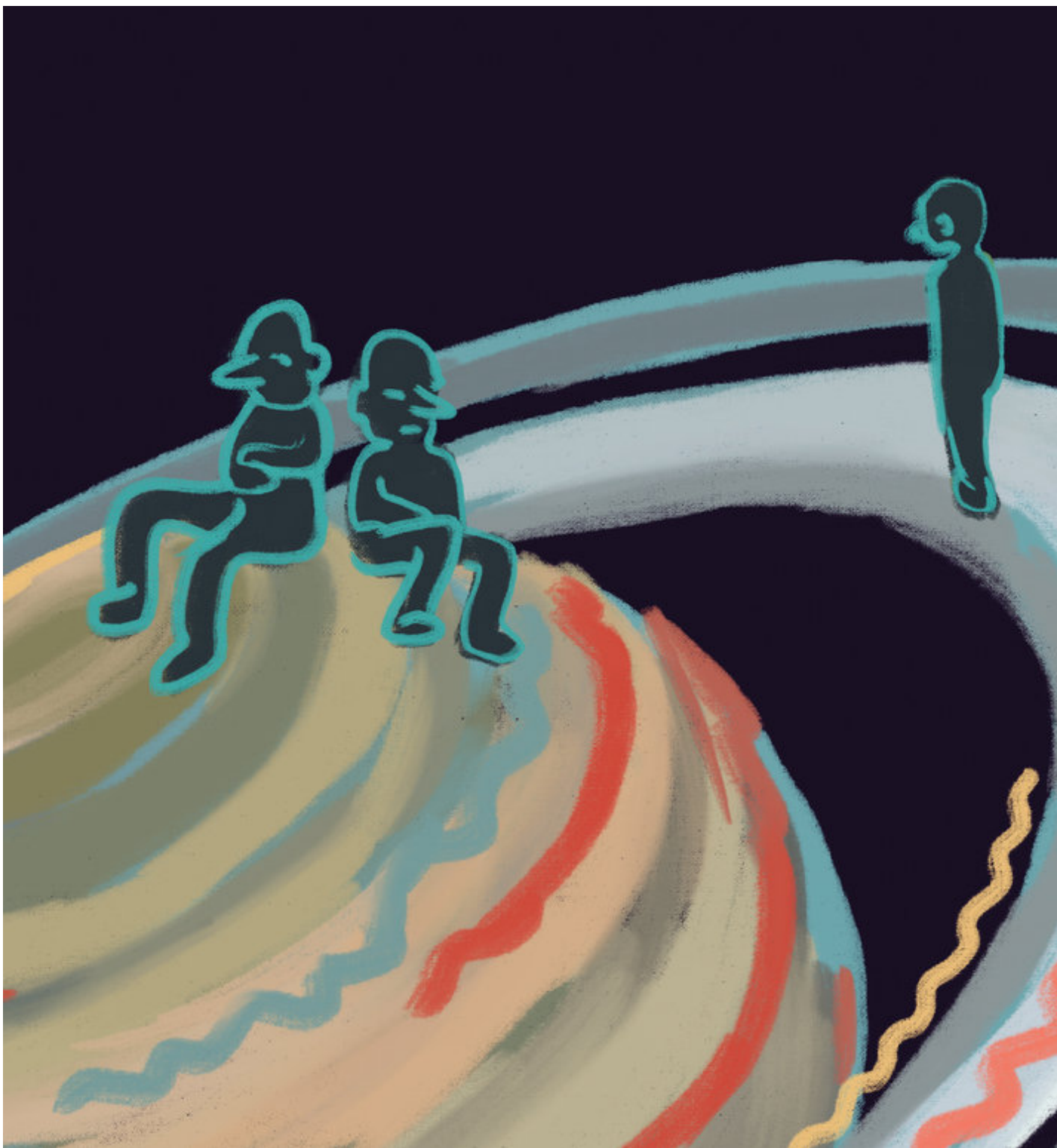

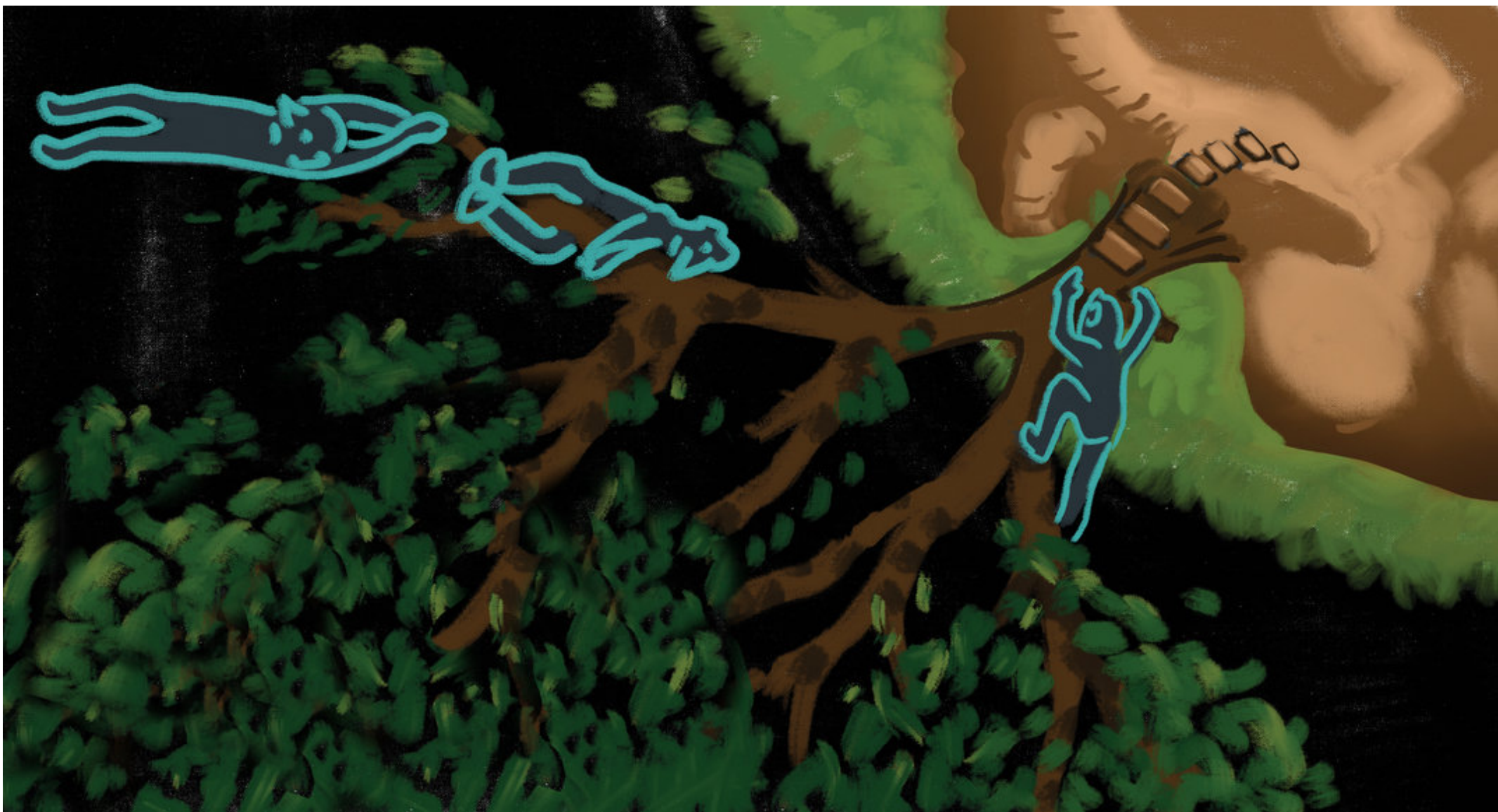




— Oh, avant, beaucoup de gens tombaient...

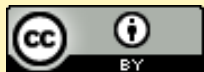
