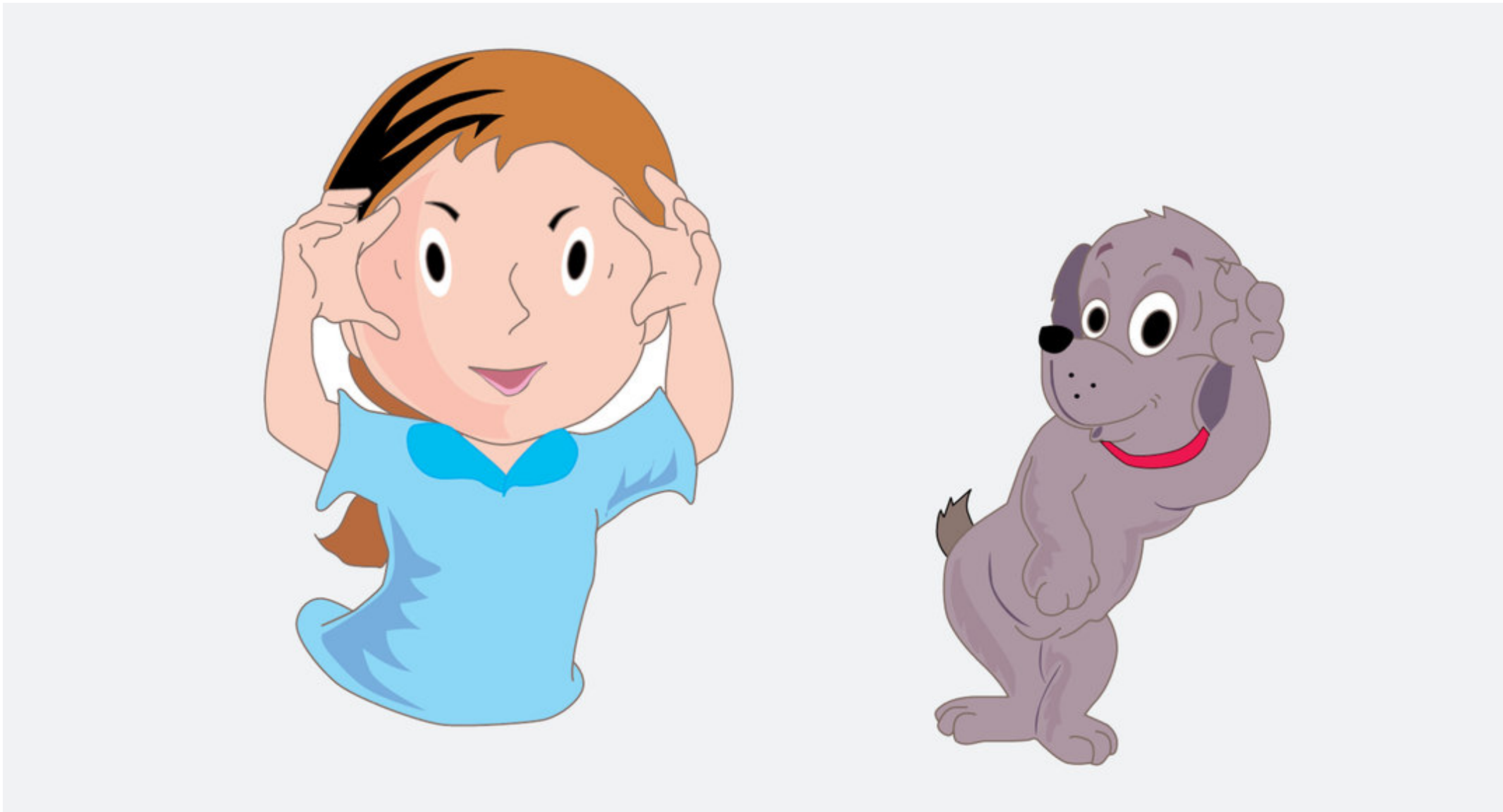

Enfin, le rêve de Timmy est devenu réalité.

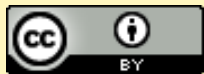

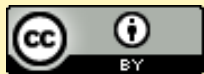
