« DES MONSTRES ! »



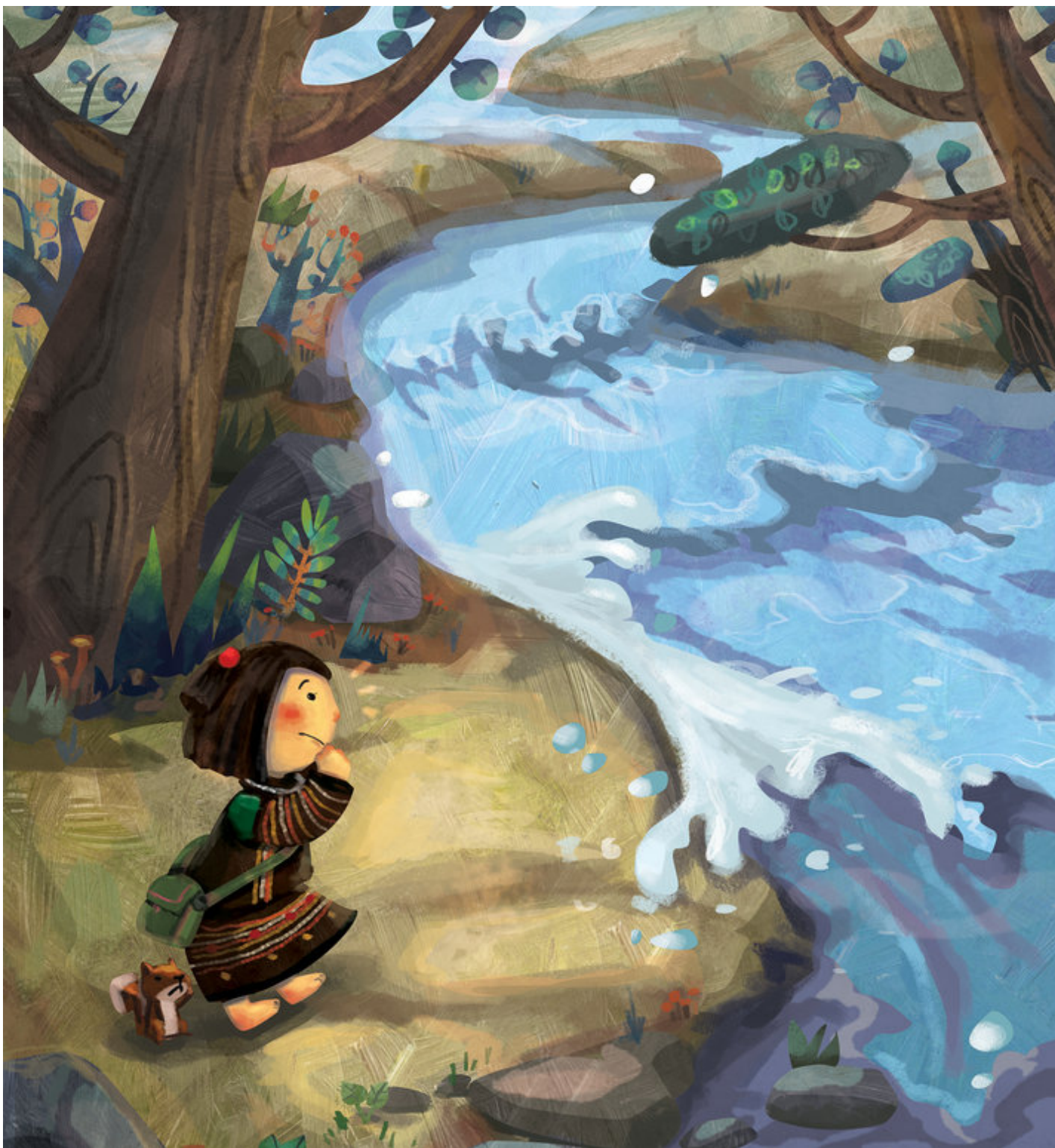
Trang éclaire les buissons avec sa lampe de poche.

Noisette est rassuré.



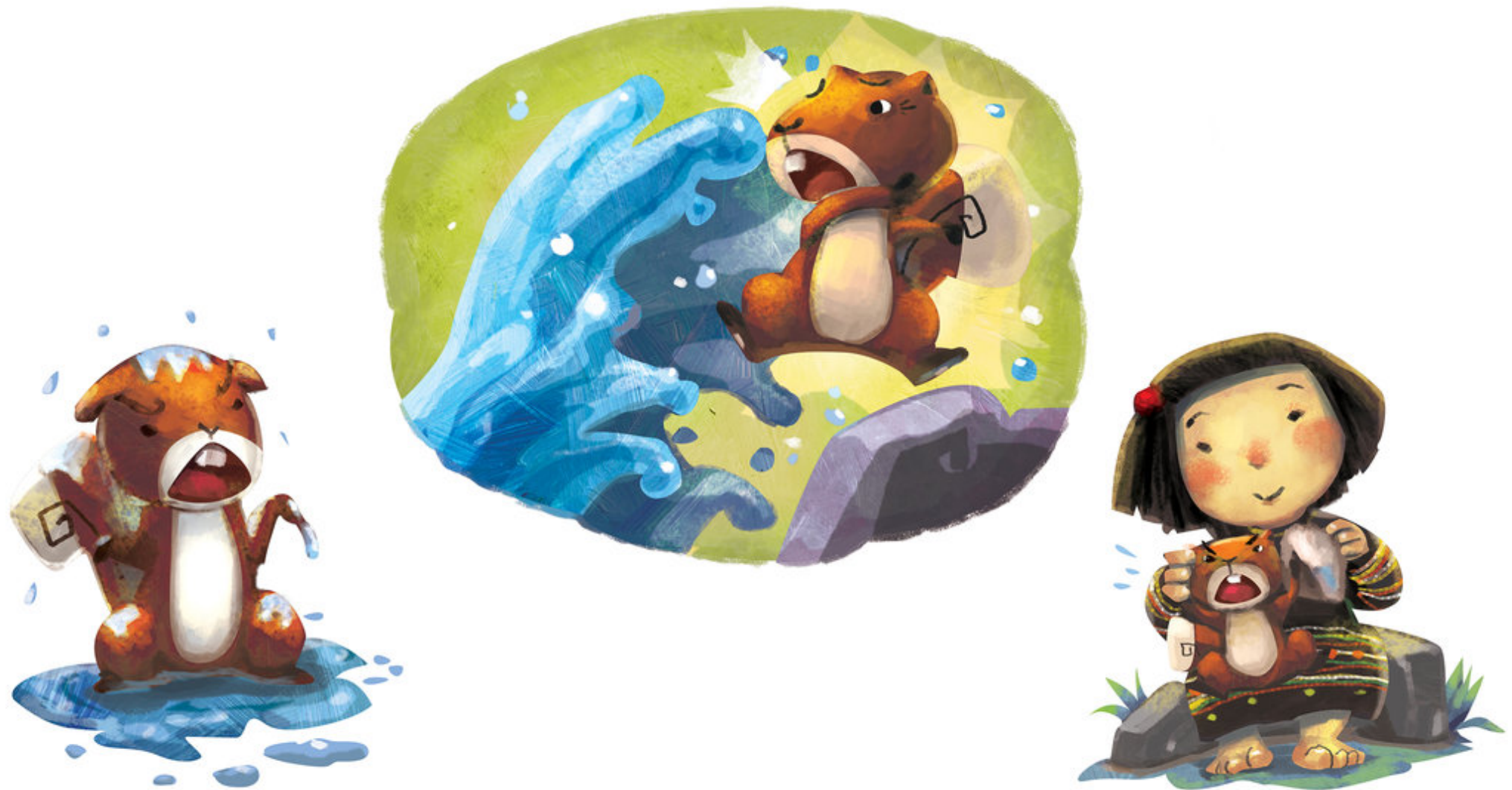


Les deux amis

Il adore l'école !





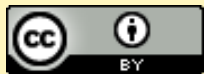

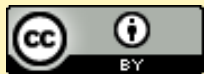
