Chaque jour, son père emmène un oiseau avec lui dans la forêt pour l'aider à en capturer d'autres.



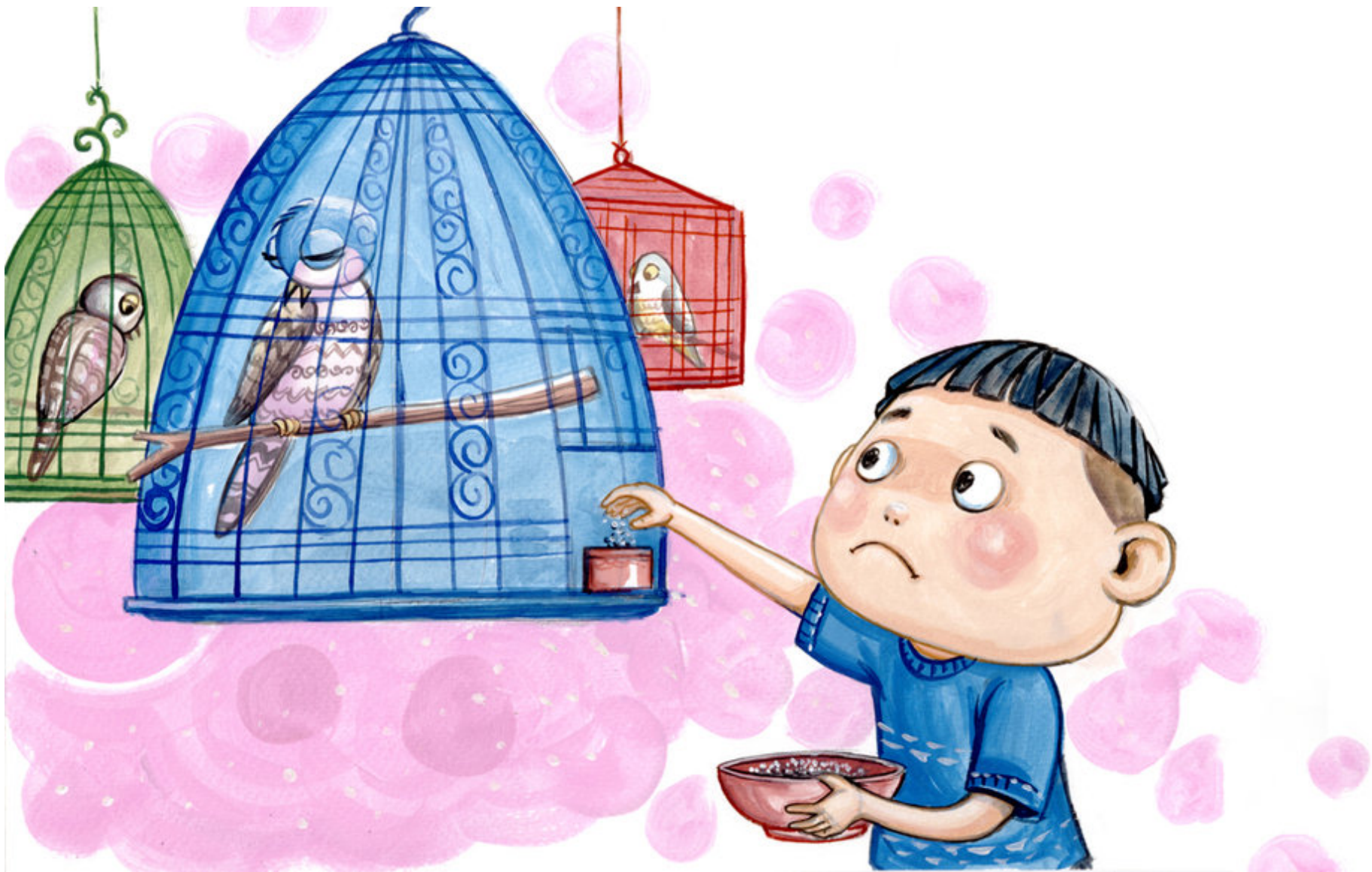
Il attrape tous les oiseaux de la forêt les uns après les autres

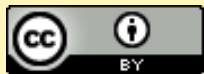
