



— Akash, reprend l'institutrice, AUCUNE PERSONNE ne se déplace sur les plafonds. Elle tomberait.



— Alors, Madame, si TikTik peut courir la tête en bas, pourquoi est-ce que je ne pourrais pas, moi ?


— Parce que TikTik est un lézard et pas toi, Akash !

Akash a soudain une idée.



monde à l'envers !






*TU PENSES que les gens devraient étudier les pattes de TikTik

De la bande adhésive qui ne collerait pas


*Des affiches de films




*Des pansements qui ne feraient pas mal
