



Et voilà les fourmis qui se mettent en route, en file indienne.


Elles marchent longtemps, jusqu'au coucher du soleil.

« Eh, regardez ce que j'ai trouvé ! »






Et voilà les fourmis qui repartent dans la nuit, en file indienne.
