— Pourquoi pas ? Toi qui adore chanter !


Champa n'a jamais raconté à Basant que la seule et unique fois où elle est montée sur scène, elle a failli s'évanouir de peur.

Elle s'entraîne comme une folle.


Elle fredonne au saut du lit.

Quand vient son tour de chanter, sa langue devient pâteuse.


La scène est trop grande !

et essaie à nouveau...




Un COUINEMENT ridicule sort de sa bouche !
