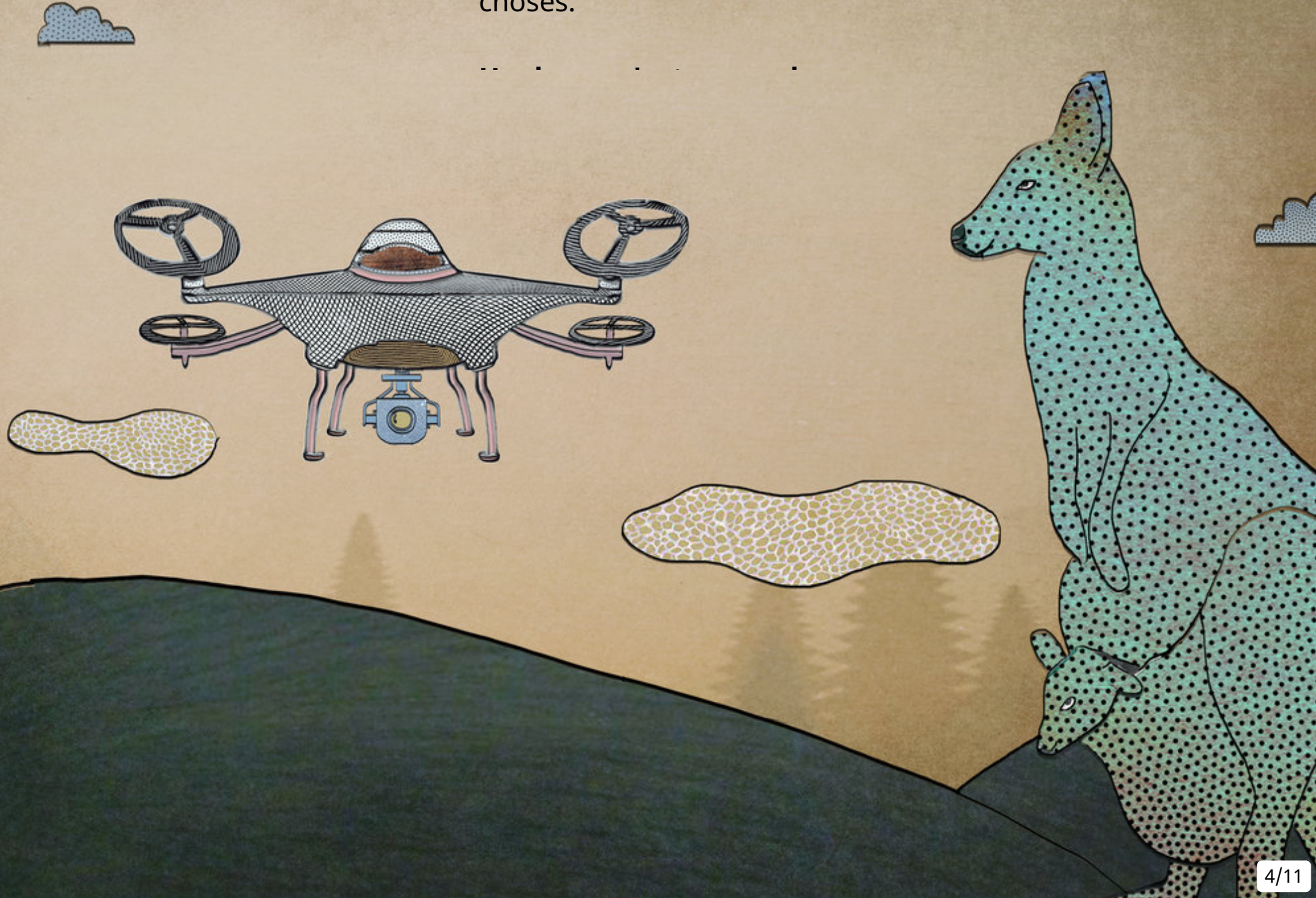



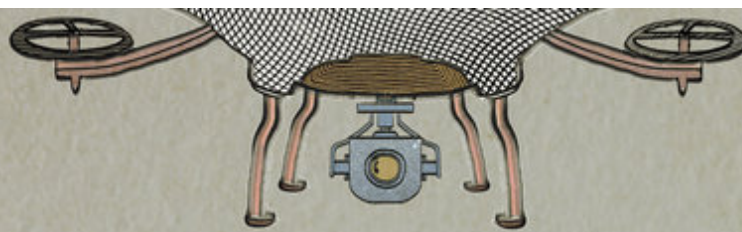

Peut-être qu'un jour bientôt, tu rencontreras un drone.



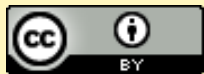
