L'essence du #6FrameStoryChallenge était de raconter une bonne histoire en utilisant seulement 6 illustrations.

La campagne a inspiré près de 70 illustrateurs à faire don de leur temps et de leurs compétences à la première plateforme d'édition d'histoires ouvertes en Inde pour les enfants.

Ce qui a commencé comme une campagne expérimentale a rapidement fleuri dans un carnaval d'art, avec l'accouchement de près de 500 nouvelles illustrations.

Ces récits traversent les barrières linguistiques, ouvrent un monde de possibilités, encouragent la communauté croissante d eStoryWeaver à rêver d'histoires multiples autour de ces images.
