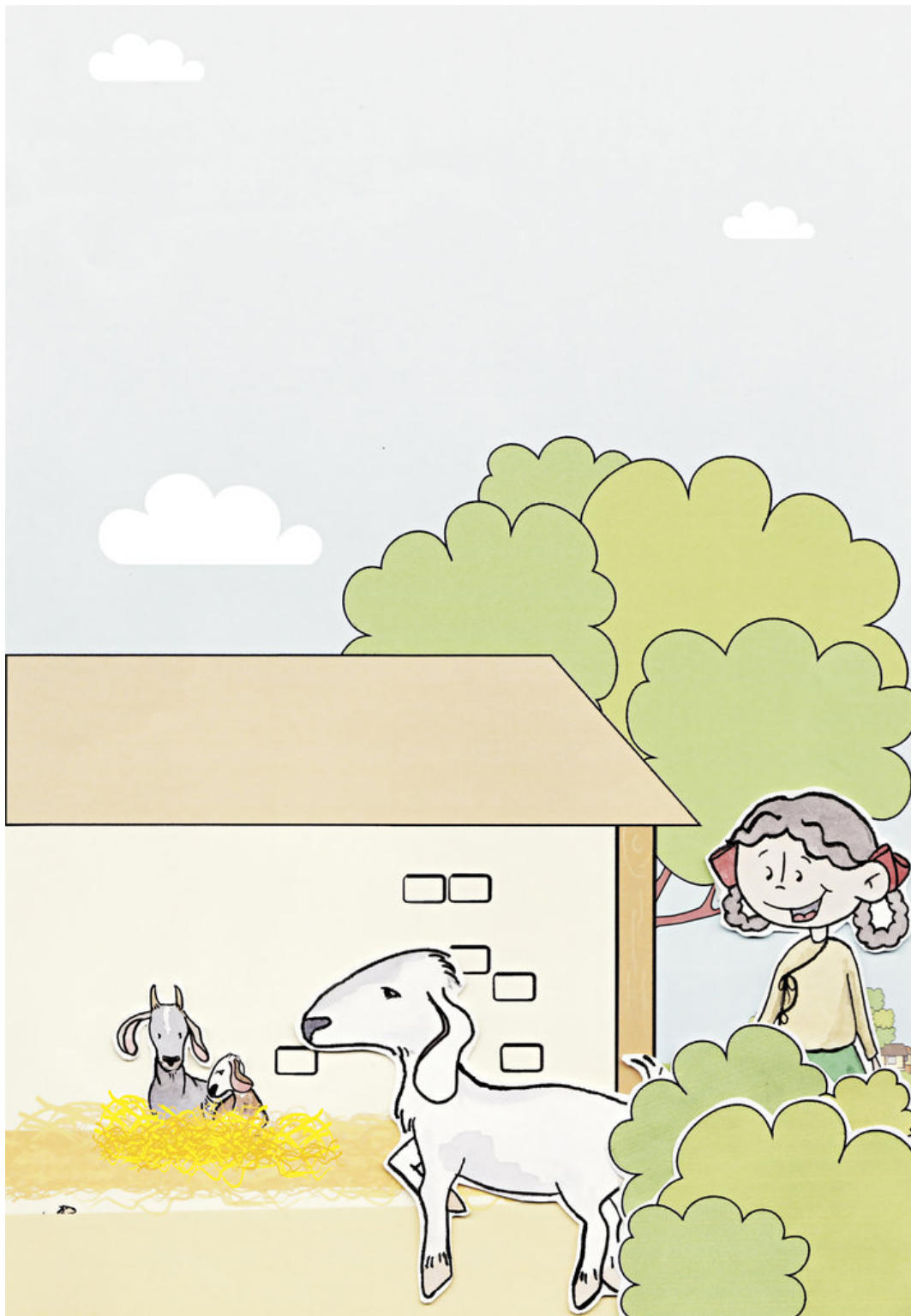
Maman Chèvre a donné naissance à deux nouveaux bébés chèvres.

Ils sont tous les deux adorables !

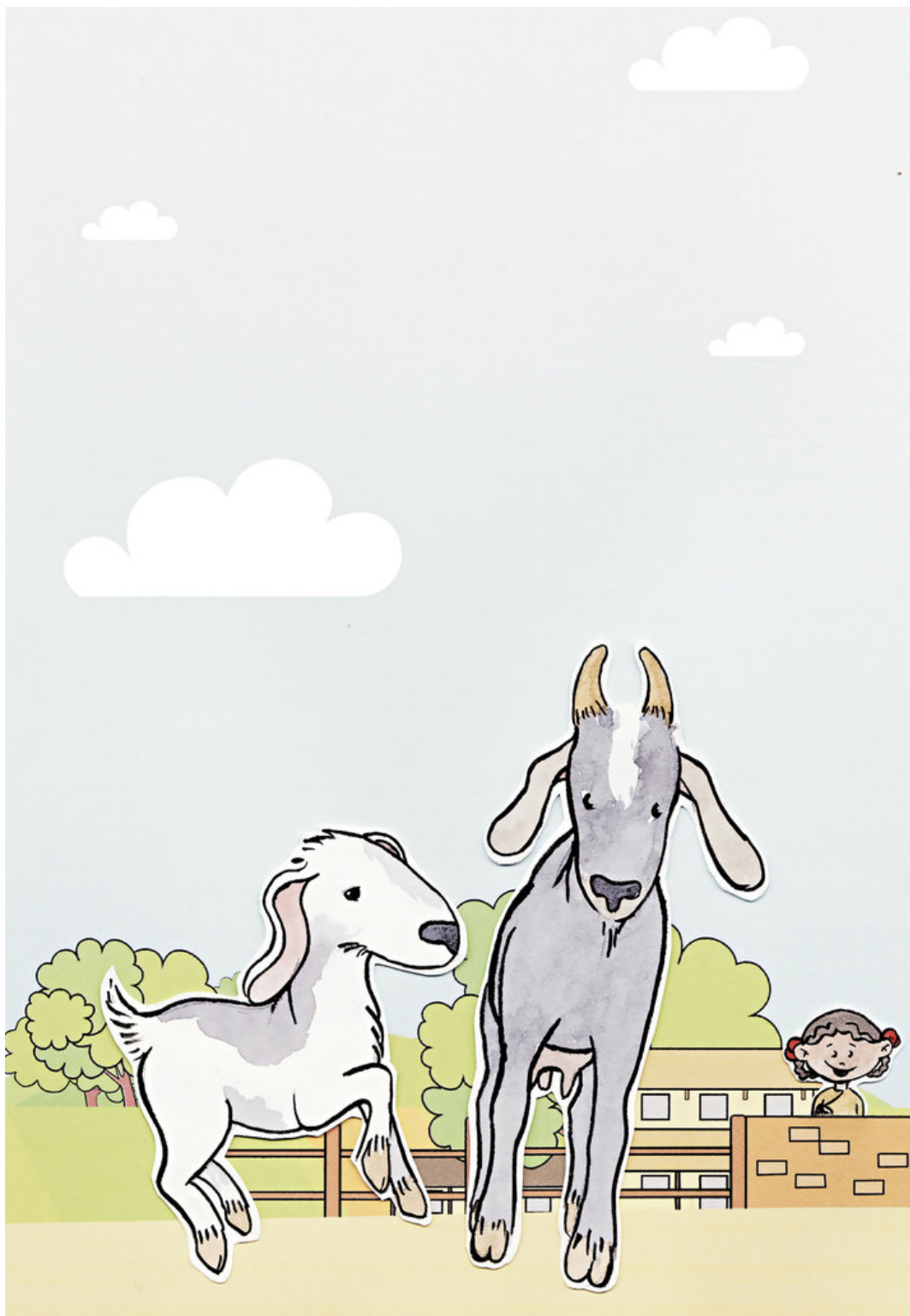


Leurs yeux sont petits et doux, leurs jambes sont soyeuses, leur museau est allongé, leurs queues frétilent.

Il appelle sa maman pour que celle-ci vienne auprès de lui.



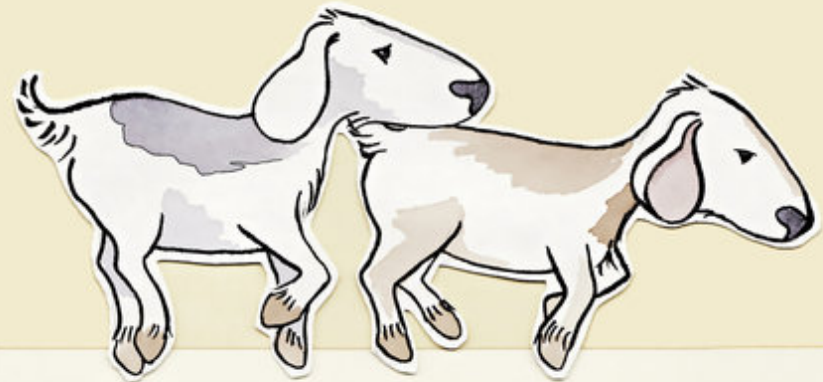
Regarde Muni jouer avec sa maman.

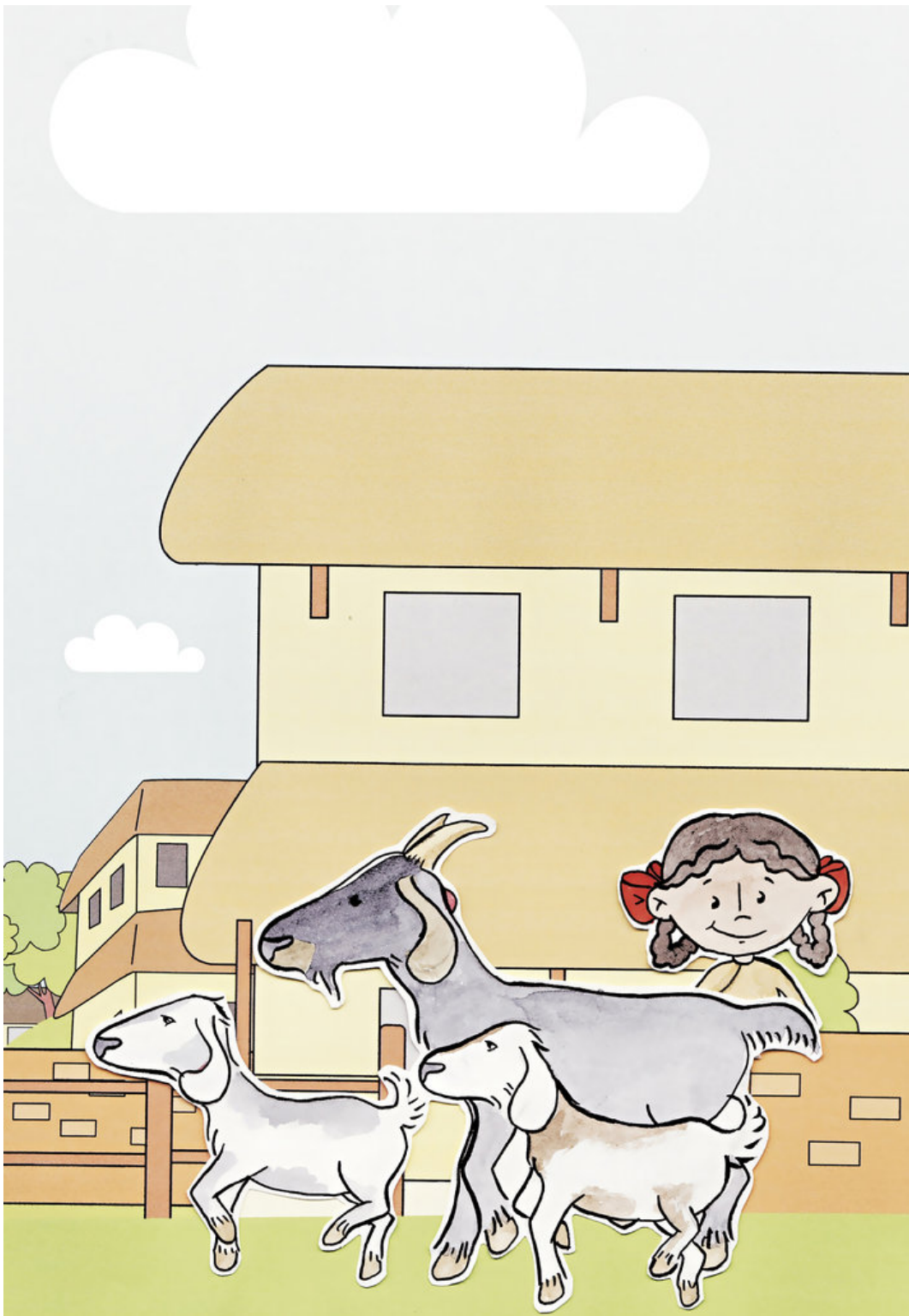
Il sautille à droite, à gauche, il fait des bonds et des cabrioles.

ne mange pas mes vêtements !

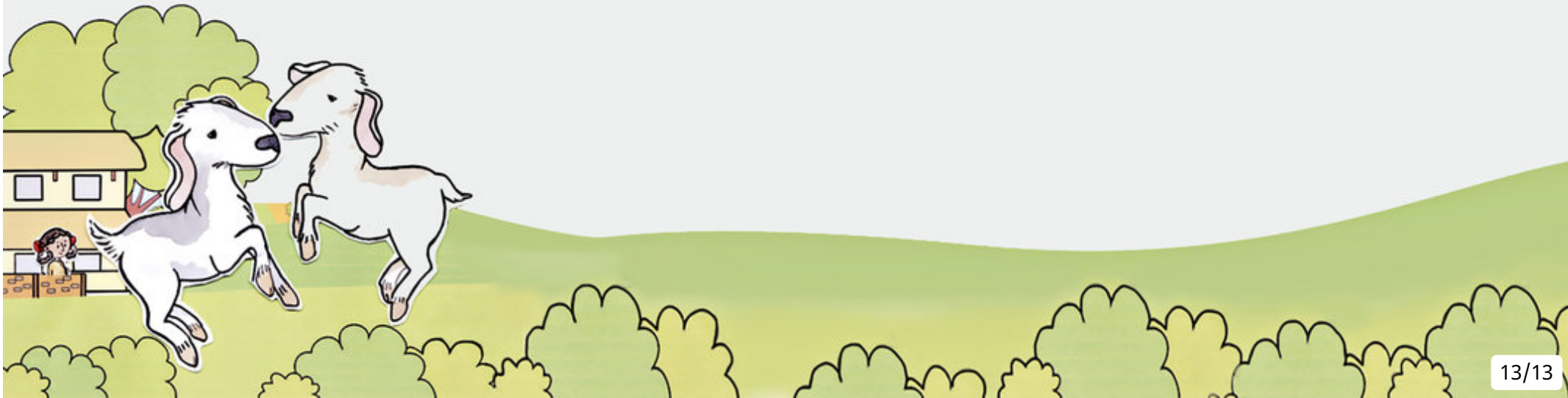
Toi qui apprends très vite, retiens bien ceci :

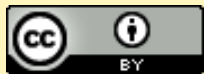
